

Street music, street art and street painting

Regulations in the city of Bamberg

What do I need a playing permit for?

- For street music: musical performances by singing and/or by musical instruments
- For other audible street art: artistic performances with music through musical instruments
- Silent street art and street painting

Who needs a playing permit?

- Individuals and groups of up to 4 people
- Groups of more than six people must submit an application for special use in public spaces.

We look forward to receiving your application.
- **Note for minors:**
 - An application for street music may only be made independently by those 16 years of age or older
 - All minors under the age of 16 require a parental consent form
 - All minors under the age of 12 are only allowed to play when accompanied by their parents

Where can I play?

In designated playing areas in Bamberg city centre. Where these are located is shown on the following page.

How and where can I obtain a playing permit?

By online application

Apply at <http://www.strassenkunst-bamberg.de> and select the date you wish to play. You will receive your playing permit electronically within the next 48 hours. The website is optimized for smartphones, so that you can easily submit applications while on the road and at any time. Please understand that not all applications can be considered due to the large number of registrations.

Do I have to pay?

Yes. Per day permit costs 15€. Payment is made online (PayPal, credit card, etc.) when registering through our online application at <http://www.strassenkunst-bamberg.de>.

What are the restrictions?

- A maximum of 4 groups of up to 4 people can play per day
- The duration of your performance may not exceed 30 minutes and the location must be changed every full hour with a minimum distance of 100 m.
- The handicapped accessible pavement in the inner city area (pedestrian zone), the entrances to buildings and the entrances of shops must always be kept clear.

When can I play?

- Monday to Saturday between 9 a.m. and 7 p.m.

When can I not play?

- All holidays, all Sundays, all "silent days" (Ash Wednesday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday, Reformation Day, All Saints' Day, National Day of Mourning, Day of Prayer and Repentance, Sunday of Death, Christmas Eve)
- During the Bamberg Christmas market, carnival, wine festival, Bamberg zaubert, Blues and Jazz Festival

What is **not allowed**?

- The passing on of the playing permission to other persons or groups
- Making music with particularly loud instruments (e.g. drums, brass instruments, etc.)
- The use of a loudspeaker system is not permitted. Likewise, the use of megaphones and gigaphones is not permitted.

- Performances outside the approved playing areas
- The use of green spaces
- The impairment of traffic and pedestrian traffic or public safety and order
- The harassment of other persons, local businesses and residents

May I sell CD's, DVD's, etc.?

Special regulation due to Corona:

Reference is made to § 21 Para. 2 of the 6th Bavarian Infection Control Regulations - in the currently valid version.

A minimum distance of 1.50 m is to be maintained between the participants (i.e. listeners and artists), for singing a minimum distance of 2 m is to be maintained.
